

As Historians

We will look into the use of plants through medicines over time and their uses. For example - perfumes, herbs for cooking.

We will look into old recipes and see how they have developed over time.

The children will: Investigate the life cycle of plants by growing various plants in class. Learn how plants reproduce through seed production and observe how plants grow from seeds over time. Write instructions and plant diaries linked to their work in science. Continue to have daily spelling, punctuation, and grammar sessions. Engage in daily guided reading lessons with a focus on comprehension tasks.
